Open pit \pm 100' dia. old. It - 25-60 - 7-2.

Considerable bf and fe staining in steep, NW zone, for load-guy.

A. V. T. bed - bedded, gently dipping med gray ls, fairly pure. Some zones, perhaps 20' thick with chert horizons. At extreme there are 1-2" very discontinuous lenses alternating with 4-6" beds good ls.

B. 100' long E-W face. Carb boulders generally $<$ 12" in a very shaly, non-sch matrix. Some of boulders are dol; majority ls.

C. Pure ls + chert. Chert perhaps in zones 20' thick, making up \pm 1/5 in $<$ 3" very layers separated by $<$ 6" ls.

Disc. - 1. Small pit at extreme NW end. Med. gray, f g.
x-ray: Cal 0.5; very large Dol 4 Q₃ 2

Disc. - 2. Quarry. Med. gray, $<$ 5mm.
x-ray: Cal 0.5; very large Dol 1 Q₃ 3
