 1. (see map) \pm 200' long trench along hillside. Disc Bari No. 1 but work much older. White barite very poorly exposed. appears to be v. irregular but generally trending N 45 E. \pm 4' exposed in one place (Bari-1). C. R. is chert (Bari-2) that appears to strike N 35 E, dip 40 W.
 2. S 10 E, 150', near top ridge, has been exposed for 50' in old workings. vein nearly N-S, and could be continuation. Poorly exposed. \pm exposed. C. R. is gray or greenish chert (-3)
 3. Elsewhere in area minor old steps & scat steps of bedded chert.
 4. Eastern-most workings are on rim in chert. about steps dark green purple igneous on ridge & slope SE of Pollard Canyon.
