

RMGC recently abandoned two geothermal production wells. The well names are (G)PW-1 and (G)PW-2. The Sundry notices were submitted to the Division of Minerals. The wells were abandoned pursuant to NAC 534A.490. Cement was used to plug the total depth of the wells. The well abandonment activity was completed January 24, 2007.
