

Earth Summit

The United Nations Conference on Environment and Development (UNCED), the "Earth Summit," will meet this June in Rio de Janeiro. A survey of UNCED Preparatory Committee reports (A/CONF.151/PC) available in GPD's Readex collection reveals a wide environmental and social agenda: biodiversity, desertification control, toxic wastes management, control of population growth, eradication of poverty, and numerous other issues.

Earth Summit comes on the twentieth anniversary of the UN Conference on the Human Environment. The Conference bibliography is available in GPD in microfiche (G5). This conference created the United Nations Environment Programme, whose Governing Council documents (UNEP/GC.) include such notable series as The State of the World Environment. Another landmark leading to Earth Summit was the publication in 1987 of the World Commission on Environment and Development's report, Our Common Future (UNEP/GC.14/13), which called for an international conference on sustainable development. This report is also available in the main library (HD75.6 .O97 1987).

Short articles on UNCED are appearing regularly in such UN periodicals as Our Planet, Development Forum, and UN Chronicle. Environment/development topics are also covered in Industry and Environment; World Development and its successor, Choices; Habitat News; Desertification Control Bulletin; Cooperation South; and Sources. See DEVELOPING COUNTRIES, this issue, for more publications on sustainable development.
