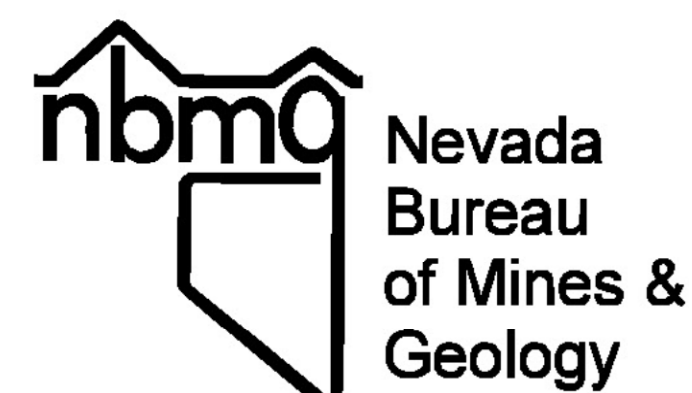
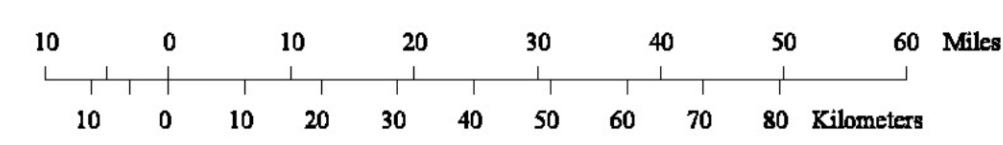

This map lists and shows the location of major active mines in Nevada. The information was the most current and reliable available to the author up through December 2002. The commodities of these mines include precious metals, industrial minerals, sand and gravel, and gemstones. The main sources of this information were the "Directory of Nevada Mine Operations, January - December 2001" compiled by the mine inspectors at Nevada Mine Safety and Training, "The Nevada Mineral Industry 2002" compiled by the Nevada Bureau of Mines and Geology, and "Major Mines of Nevada 2002" compiled by the Nevada Division of Minerals. These sources were supplemented with information from many other more specialized sources such as company reports, the Internet, Geological Society of Nevada guidebooks, magazine and journal articles, topographic maps, and contact with people working within the mining industry.

This information should be considered preliminary. It has not been edited or checked for completeness or accuracy.
